A few steps from the main thoroughfare between Christ Church college and Westgate Oxford, our spaces are within reach of Oxford's research and creative industries and universities.


Originally built as a brewery, the building offers many spaces each with their own unique architectural tone, atmospheric features and original ironwork.

THE CAFÉ

THE CAFÉ is an architecturally significant example of a fully renovated post-industrial space, complete with black iron pillars from the Oxford ironworks in Jericho, as well as the original vaulted ceiling of the old brewery buildings.

The space is fully accessible by lift and ramp, and has dimmable multiple temperature lights for setting the mood. You are welcome to use your own equipment or the designer furniture at the gallery.

The Café makes for an excellent reception before your gallery tour or during the interval to a performance. It can also be used independently for concerts, receptions and parties.

Bright and clear, the Café is the best place for presenting to groups of 50 or more. If you are looking for a smaller area, look no further than the Basement.








THE BASEMENT
